**Note:** in 2017-2018 academic year, the graduation rate was 845 people, of which: 724-bachelor's degree, 121-master's degree. According to SCPP data for 11.10.2018, pension contributions were made: bachelor's degree-41% of graduates, master's degree-63.1%. The share of graduates of the 2017-2018 academic year is the specialty "Jurisprudence" -252 (bachelor's degree), i.e., 35% of the total number of graduates, 60 (master's degree), i.e., 49.5% of the total number of graduates. 40% of employed graduates of this specialty who do not have pension contributions are law enforcement officers, and on the basis of the law of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On provision of pension" of 21.06.2013, employees of special state and law enforcement agencies are exempt from paying mandatory pension contributions (article 24, paragraph 2, paragraph 3).

In addition, 16 graduates KRIU do the masters in KRIU (3 - Jurisprudence, 3 Management, 4 Finance, 2-Design, 3 - Psychology 3 - LSEP) and 27 are on leave to care for a child, 4 - departure outside the Republic of Kazakhstan, 22 - are youth training in the direction of SI "Employment center", 10 – service in the armed forces of Kazakhstan, i.e. 79 graduate belong to the category of the employed population.
