Note: in 2018-2019 academic year, the graduation rate was 887, of which 806 – bachelor’s degree and 81 - master's degree. According to SCPP data as of 31.01.2019, pension contributions were made: graduates of bachelor's degree-41%, master's degree-63.1%. The share of graduates of the 2018-2019 academic year, is the specialty "Jurisprudence" -354 (bachelor's, master's), i.e. 40% of the total number of graduates.

39.3% of employed graduates of this specialty who do not have pension contributions are law enforcement officers, military personnel (except for conscripts). On the basis of the law of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On provision of pension" dated 21.06.2013, № 105-V (with amendments and additions as of 24.04.2019), military personnel (except conscripts), employees of special state and law enforcement agencies are exempt from paying mandatory pension contributions (article 24, paragraph 2, paragraph 3).

Besides:

- 6 graduates are studying in the master's program of KRIU** (Luparev Andrey-specialty "Design", Lam Islam, Tulegenova Maira-specialty "LSEP", Mukhambetkaliev Askar-specialty "Jurisprudence", Orazaly Medet-specialty "Management", Aidarova Ainur – specialty "Finance").
- 48 graduates do work experience** in the direction of the SI "Center of employment" (Law of RK "On provision of pension" dated 21.06.2013 №105-V from payment of mandatory pension contributions of the employer in a single accumulative pension fund shall be **exempt agent for: the unemployed sent by the employment center** within the framework of active measures of employment on social workplaces, public work and (or) **youth practice**
- 8 - service in the armed forces of the RK**(in accordance with the Law of the RK "On employment" from 02.08.2015 No. 342-V(with

[amendments and acts](#) as 03.04.2019) **to employees (article 4)** refers to persons serving **in the Armed Forces**, other troops and military formations, law enforcement and special state bodies of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

4. **6 - departure from the Republic of Kazakhstan**, i.e. 129 graduates belong to the category of the employed population.

Thus, with the above categories of citizens related to the category of the employed population on the basis of the Law of RK "On population employment", the employment of graduates in 2019, at 31.01.2020, was 81.8 % (as of 25.10.2019, manpower constituted 69.8 % (bachelor's degree -70,5 %, master's degree – 63%).
